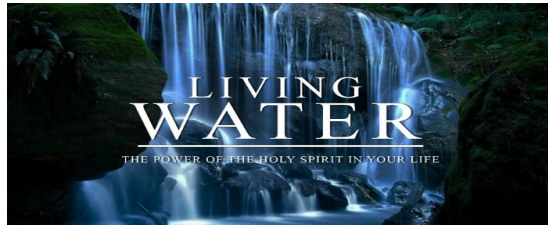

Shorter Catechism
